CEDAR FALLS – Ruth Peterson, 87, of Cedar Falls died Wednesday, April 29th at Western Home Communities Windcove.

She was born July 8, 1932 in Cedar Falls, Iowa, daughter of Bernard and Gladys (Kielty) Caley. She married James L. Peterson on February 20, 1953 in the First Methodist Parsonage in Cedar Falls.
