February 6, 1922 - January 26, 2006

CEDAR FALLS --- Albert R. Booth, 83, of Friendship Village, Waterloo, formerly of Cedar Falls, died Thursday, Jan. 26, at the Cedar Valley Hospice Home, Waterloo.
