Alma Christensen Jepperson (1915-2018)

CEDAR FALLS-Alma Christensen Jepperson, 102, of Cedar Falls, died Sunday, June 3, 2018 at her son's home in Vienna, MO.

She was born June 13, 1915 in Butler County, IA, the daughter of William and Annie DeGroote Hassman. She married Chester Christensen November 25, 1942 in Waterloo. He died May 13, 1965. She then married Willis Jepperson February 19, 1982 in Cedar Falls. He died October 19, 2003.

Alma attended Iowa State Teachers College (UNI) and received her teaching degree. She taught a total of 36 years, the last 20 in Cedar Falls at Lincoln Elementary and Peet Junior High.
