Angeline Mirkovich Lovegren, known to all as Bunny, beloved and loving mother, mother-in-law, grandmother, wife, died Saturday, May 16, age 80, at Windsor Care Center, Cedar Falls, Iowa. Bunny grew up in Crosby, the fourth child of George and Josie Mirkovich, graduating from C-I High School in 1946.
