Anne Kathryn Geadelmann, 77, of Cedar Falls, died Friday, November 29, 2019, at the Cedar Valley Hospice Home in Waterloo. Anne received a B.A. in Speech Therapy at Elmhurst College in Elmhurst, IL and was a speech therapist in Glen Ellyn, IL and Blackhawk Co, IA.
