CEDAR FALLS- Genevieve A. Schlicher, 98, of Cedar Falls, died Thursday, March 22, 2012, at Sartori Memorial Hospital in Cedar Falls.

She was born July 30, 1913, in Mt. Sterling, Iowa, daughter of William J. and Myrtle (Walker) Fowler. She married Raymond Schlicher on May 22, 1938 in Iowa City. He died December 18, 1990.

Mrs. Schlicher graduated from Knoxville High School and attended Iowa Wesleyan College and graduated from the University of Iowa in 1937 with a Bachelor's degree in Commerce (accounting). She was a homemaker and worked part-time at the Registrar's Office at the University of Northern Iowa. She was a member of First United Methodist Church in Cedar Falls.
