Bernhard E. Jacobson (1919-2013)

CEDAR FALLS- Bernhard E. Jacobson, 94, of Cedar Falls, died Saturday, July 6, 2013, at NewAldaya Lifescapes in Cedar Falls.

He was born June 15, 1919 in Palisade, Minnesota, son of Emil and Fanny (Carlson) Jacobson. He married Mary Cain Campbell on August 25, 1944 in Cedar Falls. She died December 3, 1995.

Mr. Jacobson attended high school in Northfield, Minnesota, graduating in 1936. He served in the US Navy during WWII and was Chief Engineer with Universal Industries, retiring in 1984.

Bernhard was an avid reader of history, science, math and religion. For many years, he and his wife spent several weeks in the Jackson Hole, WY area where he hiked, climbed Grand Teton and Mount Moran and rode horses.
