CEDAR FALLS- Betty L. Weikert, 85, of NewAldaya Lifescapes died Wednesday, August 10, 2011 at Sartori Memorial Hospital in Cedar Falls.

She was born January 10, 1926 in Cedar Falls, the daughter of F.E. and Dagmar (Iversen) Jones. She married J. Roy Weikert on July 1, 1948 in Eldon, Missouri. He died January 24, 2004.

She graduated from Cedar Falls High School in 1943 and was the bookkeeper with Jones DX in Cedar Falls, which she co-owned with her husband for thirty-eight years, retiring in 1988. Through the years, she was also employed with Israel Menswear in Cedar Falls. She was a lifetime member of First United Methodist Church in Cedar Falls, American Legion Auxiliary, and Cedar Falls Chapter #78 OES.

Survived by: two sons, Jerry of Kirkland, WA, and Rod (Kellie) of West Des Moines; and two grandchildren, Emily Weikert of Denver, CO, and Joel Weikert of West Des Moines.

Preceded in death by: a sister, Fonda Arenholz.
