Beverly "Jane" Danielsen (1930-2011)

CEDAR FALLS- Beverly "Jane" Danielsen, 81, of Cedar Falls died Monday, January 2, 2012, at the Cedar Falls Healthcare Center.

She was born December 3, 1930 in Cedar Falls, daughter of Harrison "Skin" and Inez (Bacon) Cole. She married Robert Felse in 1950 in Hamilton, California, and they later divorced. She married Wayne O. Danielsen on December 11, 1954 in Cedar Falls. He died January 20, 2001.
