CEDAR FALLS – Beverly N. Oltman, 90, of Cedar Falls died Thursday, January 12, 2017 at Western Home Communities Windhaven.

She was born November 7, 1926 in Manly, Iowa, daughter of Rush and Emma (Holden) Culver. She married Max Oltman on March 26, 1948 in Manly, Iowa. He died on July 27, 2003.
