Bill was born August 13, 1923, in Waterloo, Iowa, the son of Ray and Irene (Courter) Camlin. In June of 1942, he was united in marriage to Lois J. Grooten in Waterloo. She died April 3, 1998. He served his Country in the United States Navy during World War II in the South Pacific. He was an electrician with the I.B.E.W.
