Billie E. Cheney (1914-2013)

CEDAR FALLS- Billie E. Cheney, 98, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, January 28, 2013, at the Western Home Communities Elizabeth E. Martin Health Center.

She was born September 25, 1914, in Harlowton, Montana, daughter of William J. and Theresa (Westfall) Cameron. She married Cedric S. Siglin in 1938 and they later divorced. In 1956 she married Lester F. Cheney in Cedar Falls. He died September 26, 2002.

She graduated from Waterloo East High School in 1933 and attended Pitzes Beauty School. She was a homemaker throughout her adult life.
