



## Bob Winters

November 24, 1938 - March 10, 2022

CEDAR FALLS – Robert “Bob” Mathew Winters, 83, died Thursday March 10, 2022, at the Cedar Falls Health Care Center.

He was born November 24, 1938, in Decorah, IA, the son of Andrew and Angela (Blong) Winters. He graduated from Janesville High School in 1958 and went on to serve in the United States Army.
