DIKE – Brad Allan Sherwood, 56, died on Friday, February 23, 2024, at his home. The cause of death is still being determined.

He was born on January 17, 1968, in Cedar Falls, IA, the son of Darryl and Peggy (Oltman) Sherwood. He graduated from Dike High School in 1986 before attending Ellsworth and Hawkeye Community Colleges. Shortly after graduation, he started working full-time at L&M Transmission. In 1997, he began volunteering for the Cedar Falls Fire Department. He was hired full-time with the Cedar Falls Fire Department in 2001 and was promoted to Captain in 2009. In 2015, he was honored as the Fire Department's Fire Officer of the Year. He was the last professional firefighter in Cedar Falls.

Brad met the love of his life, Carrie Panther, in 2005 and they were united in marriage on March 16, 2012, in Dike.

Brad is survived by his wife; daughter, Madeline (Devon) Dyer of Lone Tree; son, Carter (Lia Murillo) Sherwood of Cedar Falls; mother, Peggy Sherwood; and sister Julie (Tim) Leonard of Norwalk, and many close friends.

He was preceded in death by his father.

Funeral services will be 10:00 a.m. Saturday, March 2, 2024, at Fredsville

Lutheran Church in rural Cedar Falls. Visitation will be 4:00-7:00 p.m. Friday, March 1, at Fredsville Lutheran Church. Interment at Fredsville Lutheran Church Cemetery.
