



## Budd Nicol

February 12, 1925 - October 19, 2005

Budd was born February 12, 1925, in Minneapolis, MN, the son of George Augustas and Ellen (Lunkley) Nicol. He attended Iowa State Teachers College for 3 years and served his Country in the United States Army during World War II. On January 18, 1947, he was united in marriage to Katherine Ann Hansen in Waterloo, IA. She died March 20, 2000. He was employed as an electrician at the University of Northern Iowa and for several years taught electronic at Hawkeye Community College, retiring in 1990.
