CEDAR FALLS- Carl F. Bruihler, 92, of Cedar Falls, died Tuesday, September 22, 2009 at the Western Home Communities Stanard Assisted Living.

He was born March 25, 1917 in Lansing, the son of Gottfried C. and Ada (Guenther) Bruihler. He married Myrtle M. Olsen on February 6, 1954 in Sumner. She died April 6, 2002.

Mr. Buihler graduated from Hawkeye High School in 1935, and served in the United States Marine Corps during World War II. He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Upper Iowa University in 1952 and his Bachelor of Science degree in Pharmacy in 1955 from Drake University. He worked as a Pharmacist until his retirement in 1989.

Survivors include three sons, John (Debra) Bruihler of Rushford, MN, Carl (Mary Kay) Bruihler, Jr. of St. Peter, MN, and Bill (Ruth Anne Rasmusson) Bruihler of Montenegro.

Preceded in death by two sisters, Belva (in infancy) and Ruth Mashek.
