Carl Eugene Durnell, 85, of Cedar Falls, died Tuesday, November 29, 2022, at UnityPoint Allen Hospital in Waterloo.

He was born April 21, 1937, in Detroit, MI, the son of Frank and Marion (White) Durnell. He earned his GED and served his country as a Sergeant in the U.S. Army during Vietnam and the Bay of Pigs. On January 9, 1965, he was united in marriage to Susan Wolff in Waterford, MI. He drove concrete trucks for various businesses, most recently being Van Horn Brothers Concrete in Waterford. After his retirement in 1993, he served as a parking enforcement police officer in Orange County, FL, and a courtesy driver for Community Motors in Iowa. He also is a lifetime member of the VFW.

He was an avid car and sports enthusiast. He played on several men's fastpitch teams in Waterford, MI. After retiring from the sport, he chose to become an umpire. He officiated men's fastpitch and high school baseball for several years. He also coached, mentored and followed his daughters in their sporting adventures of fastpitch softball and basketball. He also was actively involved in his grandchildren's sporting events; Chad with football, Conor with hockey, Nyah with dance, and Miah with dance and pole vaulting.

Carl is survived by his wife; two daughters, Carla (Clyde) Luck of Cedar Falls and Sheila Gonzalez of Orlando, FL; grandchildren: Chad (Ashley) Luck and Conor Luck of Cedar Falls, Nyah and Miah Gonzalez of FL, and great-grandchild, Theo Luck.

He was preceded in death by four brothers and six sisters.
