



## Carl Hundley

March 29, 1920 - March 12, 2010

Carl M. Hundley, 89, of Cedar Falls, Iowa, died Friday, March 12, 2010, at his home.

He was born March 29, 1920 near Finchford, Iowa in Butler County, the son of John and Ida Giesler Hundley. He married Norma Lee Phelps on October 12, 1940 in Waterloo.

He graduated from Finchford High School, and was employed with Rath Packing Co, Viking Pump, and Manning Pattern Co, before starting his farming career west of Cedar Falls, in 1943. He was a Pioneer Seed Corn salesman for fourteen years, retiring in 1985.

He was on the Board of Directors for Black Hawk Mutual Insurance Association from 1969 to 1987. He also served as Farm Bureau Secretary and Cedar Falls Bible Conference Treasure. In his retirement, he realized he had an artistic side and he enjoyed making wood crafts, metal scratch art, and drawings for his family and others.

Carl is survived by his wife of nearly 70 years, Norma; a daughter, Marlys (Cyrus) Bartine; a son, Bob (Dorothy) Hundley, all of Cedar Falls; several grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and sister-in-law, Francis Hundley of Cedar Falls.

He was preceded in death by his parents; six brothers, Otto, James, Roger, Leo, Floyd and Delwin Hundley; five sisters, Mary Stafford, Dorothy Stafford, Clara Stafford, Marguarite Hundley, and Bertha Ridder.
