



## Clarence "Casey" Tucker

March 17, 1930 - February 8, 2020

EVANSDALE – Clarence “Casey” Ervin Tucker, age 89, of Evansdale, Iowa, and formerly of Cedar Falls, died Saturday February 8, 2020, at Westbrook Acres in Gladbrook, Iowa, following a long illness.
