Cliff Freudenberg, 86, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, Oct. 17th, 2021, in Waterloo, IA following a brief illness.

Clifford W. Freudenberg was born in Parkers Prairie, MN to Herbert W. and Edna (Glebe) Freudenberg on August 27th, 1935. Cliff was united in marriage to Donna (Stueven) Oct. 17th, 1958. Cheryl, Mark, and Craig were born to this union. Cliff and Donna later divorced. Cliff married Joann Martenson in Feb. 1979, and they later divorced.

Cliff is survived by his children Cheryl (Tom) Wilson, Mark (Erica) Freudenberg, and Craig (Melissa) Freudenberg, and seven grandchildren. He is also survived by his sisters Ordella, Doris, and Romaine, and his brother Jerry. His parents, two brothers, Edroy and Charles, and one sister, Loretta, preceded him in death.

Cliff was the only one of he and his siblings to go to college, and he also served in the US Army, stationed in Italy. After his service, Cliff worked in a chemical plant, worked for his father-in-law at the vault company, and drove truck OTR. Cliff later retired, and moved to Waterloo, IA.

He was an avid baker and famous for his Banana Cream Pie. He enjoyed reading and watching WWII movies and he could often be found at the library. Cliff was active in his church and the choir, until he became unable to attend. He enjoyed spending time with family and looked forward to fish fries and his Christmas Eve supper of Oyster Stew and wine.
