



## Coyla McCann

August 25, 1928 - October 26, 2013

CEDAR FALLS- Coyla Elaine McCann, 85, died Saturday, Oct 26, 2013, at the Western Home Communities - Martin Center due to complications of a hemorrhagic stroke.

She was born August 25th, 1928, in rural Adair county, Iowa, daughter of Harold and Edith (Lauer) Boyd. She married Willis D. McCann August 29, 1948, at Hill of Zion Church in rural Adair county, Iowa. He preceded her in death on May 25, 2000.

Coyla received her B.A. degree in 1949 from Iowa State Teachers College (now the Univ. of Northern Iowa). She was employed with the University of Northern Iowa as a Library Associate, retiring September 1st, 1993, after 29 years of service.
