August 24, 1924 - December 23, 2017

Cedar Falls – Dale Edward Rickard, age 93, of Cedar Falls, died Saturday, December 23, at Cedar Valley Hospice Home in Waterloo.

He was born August 24, 1924 in Rolfe, IA, the son of John and Pearl (Lanning) Rickard. He graduated from Rolfe High School before entering the US Navy. On October 1, 1950, he married Margie Middents in Kamrar. Dale owned and operated Rickard's Sporting Goods and Valu-Mart in Cedar Falls from 1960-1992, before becoming an independent salesman for H&H Lights working up until his death.
