Darlene May Prashak, 96, died on Friday, February 9, 2024, at Heritage Care & Rehabilitation Center in Mason City.

She was born on May 25, 1927, in Kellogg, IA, the daughter of Joseph and Bertha (Anderson) Stecher. When she was four years old, her family moved to the farm she grew up on. She attended country school on the corner of her family's farm, being the only student through the eighth grade. She graduated from Kellogg High School before attending Drake University. She received her teaching degree and taught in Cedar Rapids for one year.

On August 24, 1949, she was united in marriage to Maynard Prashak. They lived on a farm near Guernsey before moving to Iowa City in 1960, where she worked as a substitute teacher. They moved again in 1969 to Cedar Falls when they purchased the Vagabond Motel. Besides helping her husband run the motel, she was a homemaker to her family.
