Darryl John Brumm (1956-2019)

CEDAR FALLS – Darryl John Brumm, 62, of Cedar Falls died Monday, February 25, 2019 at the Cedar Valley Hospice Home in Waterloo.

He was born April 23, 1956 in Osage, Iowa, son of John and Mary (Kasel) Brumm. He married Kelly Pirnat on June 12, 1982 in Sand Springs, Iowa.

He graduated from Mason City Newman in 1975; earned his Associates degree from NIACC; and Accounting degree from the University of Northern Iowa. He was a CPA with the State of Iowa Auditors Office, and a University of Northern Iowa Track and Field Official. He served as Treasurer of the Cedar River Runners Club and was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church where he was involved with the Knights of Columbus Council 4516.
