Delight TePaske (1931-2018)

CEDAR FALLS – Delight TePaske, 86, of Lake Suzy, Florida, formerly of Cedar Falls, died Thursday, March 8, 2018 in Florida.

She was born November 13, 1931 in Albia, Iowa, daughter of Eldon and Edna Ruth (Curtis) MacCanon. She married Russell TePaske on April 6, 1951 in Des Moines, Iowa, and they later divorced.

She was employed 20 years by the 1st Judicial District of the State of Iowa. She worked as a juvenile probation officer in the Waterloo office, retiring in 1991, when she moved to Florida.

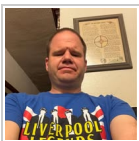
