CEDAR FALLS – G. Richard “Dick” Beal, 74, of Cedar Falls died Wednesday, August 16, 2017 at his home.

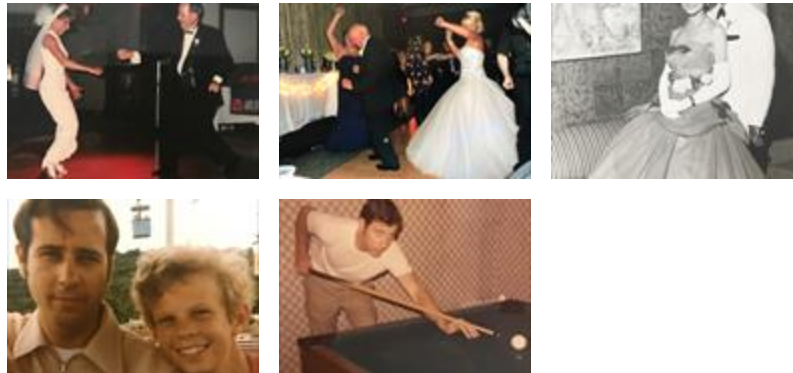

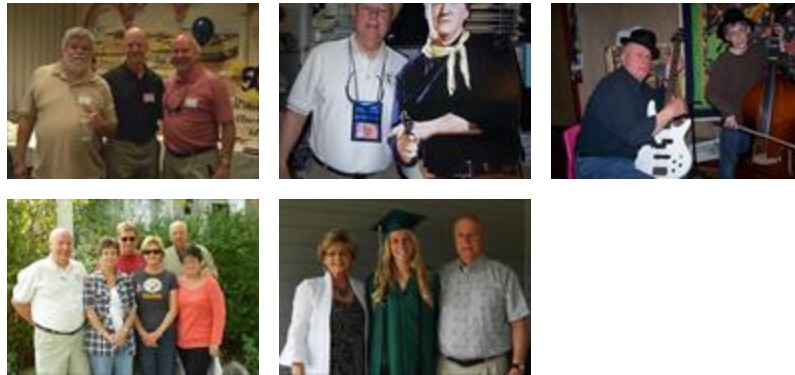
