John Richard Hills, 80 of Cedar Falls, died Sunday, January 15, 2006, at Florida Hospital in Kissimmee, Florida.

Dick was born May 13, 1925, in Cedar Falls, Iowa, the son of Harry B. and Carrie (Knudsen) Hills. He graduated from Shell Rock High School and the University of Northern Iowa (1963). He also completed graduate work at the University of Minnesota. On November 09, 1951, He was united in marriage to Ruth E. Krumme in Dunkerton. She died May 30, 1989. He taught in area country schools and then at North Cedar, Shell Rock, and Waterloo, and most recently was at Cedar Falls High School working through AEA 7, retiring in 1987. He was a 50 year member of First Baptist Church in Cedar Falls, member of the Cedar Falls Kiwanis, and a former member of the Y Men's Club.
