CEDAR FALLS – Donald D. "Don" Geesaman, 84, of Cedar Falls died Wednesday, June 14, 2017 at Western Home Communities Nation Cottage.

He was born October 9, 1932 in Villisca, Iowa, son of Franklyn and Margaret (Berry) Geesaman. He married Marilyn Madsen on August 31, 1951 in Des Moines, Iowa.
