Donald Charles Rathe, 91, of the Western Home Communities-Martin Center, Cedar Falls, died Sunday, October 16, 2005, at Allen Memorial Hospital in Waterloo. He was preceded in death by his parents; and brother, Roland Rathe of Lincoln, NE.

He was born January 10, 1914, in Sauk Centre, MN, the son of William H. and Pauline (Selinsky) Rathe. He served his Country in the United States Army during World War II. He received his BA degree in history and education from State Teacher's College (St. Cloud State) in St. Cloud, MN and his MA degree in history from the University of Iowa.

On August 24, 1946, he was united in marriage to Lucille M. Belander in Iowa City. They were later divorced. He was an American History instructor at Waterloo East High School from 1954 until his retirement in 1977.
