Donald C. Rohwedder (1928-2013)

CEDAR FALLS- Donald C. Rohwedder, 84, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, April 22, 2013, at Western Home Communities Elizabeth E. Martin Health Center.

He was born December 5, 1928 in Greene, Iowa, son of Elmer and Joyce (McChestney) Rohwedder. He married Faye Breneman on December 23, 1956, in Grinnell, Iowa.

He graduated from Greene High School in 1946 and served in the US Navy during WWII and Korea. He earned his BA degree from Iowa State Teachers College (UNI) and was employed with Clay Equipment for 35 years, retiring in 1992 as Credit Manager. He was an Eagle Scout and served as Scout Master for Troop 44. He was a member of First United Methodist Church in Cedar Falls.

Survived by: his wife, Faye; two sons, Bill (Stacy) of Cedar Falls, and John (Sara) of Birmingham, AL; eleven grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; and one sister, Beverly (Harrison) Bone of Greene.
