CEDAR FALLS- Earl C. Biersner, 83, of Cedar Falls, died Thursday, April 28, 2016, at UnityPoint-Allen Hospital.

He was born December 6, 1932 in Webster City, Iowa, son of Alexander and Esther Westrum Biersner. He married Charlotte Sprole on October 16, 1952 in Nashua, Iowa. She died October 10, 2005.
