



## Earl William Rogers

December 2, 1931 - August 30, 2014

Cedar Falls- Earl W. Rogers, 82, of Cedar Falls, died Saturday, August 30, 2014 at the Western Home Communities Elizabeth E. Martin Health Center. He was born December 2, 1931 in Waterloo, the son of Vernie and Hazel (Rogers) Rogers. He graduated from Cedar Falls High School and attended Iowa State Teachers College. On December 23, 1951 he married Joan Hull in Cedar Falls. Earl served with the US Army in England from 1951-1953. Earl worked in various jobs for Rath Packing Company, he was a case worker for the Iowa State Extension Service, and also was a rural mail carrier for the Cedar Falls Post Office, retiring in 2006.

Survived by: his wife; two daughters, Brenda (Kevin) Kirkpatrick of Cedar Falls, and Vicky (John) Nolan of Mason City; one son, Randy (Deb) of Stillwater, MN; a sister, Carol Hoeweller of Waterloo; 7 grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren.
