Ed was born April 14, 1920 in Rolfe, Iowa, the son of Ernest M. and Bertha E. (Stinson) Smith.

He served his country in the United States Army during WWII.

On September 30, 1943, he was united in marriage to Maxine C. Mann in Waterloo, Iowa. She died July 6, 1982. He then married Alice M. Kiewiet in January of 1983, in Cedar Falls, Iowa. She died March 3, 2001.

Ed was employed at Blacks Department Store in Waterloo from 1946 until his retirement in 1980.

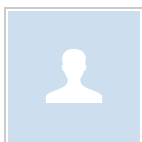


“ Nancy, Jan, and Linda,
