Eleanor Davis, 91, formerly of Cedar Falls, Iowa and Jackson, Ohio, died Wednesday, June 27, 2012, at her home in Englewood, Florida, with her daughters at her bedside. She was born September 29, 1920, in Brookville, Ohio, to Charles and Ethel Meyer, and married Myron E. Davis on July 28, 1943, in New York City. Mr. Davis died June 19, 1999.

Eleanor graduated from Brookville High School in Brookville, Ohio, and attended the Ohio State University for almost four years until her husband returned from serving in the U.S. Navy during WWII.

Eleanor was a longtime member of Grace United Methodist Church in Jackson, Ohio, an avid flower gardener, homemaker and devoted wife and mother.

She was preceded in death by her husband Myron E. Davis, their sons, Robert and Barry, her parents, four brothers, and three sisters.
