WATERLOO- Elmer W. Schnering, 92, of Waterloo, died Saturday, January 19, 2013, at his home.

He was born June 25, 1920, in Waterloo and raised in Waverly at the Lutheran Orphanage from infancy to age 15, when he went to live with his uncle in Cedar Falls. He married Delphine Haes Elmore in October 1956. She died in 1986.

He served in the US Army during WWII in Guadalcanal, and was employed with Chamberlain Manufacturing before and after the war, for a total of 45 years.
