Elton R. Olmstead (1919-2008)

CEDAR FALLS- Elton R. Olmstead, 88, of Cedar Falls, died Friday, Feb. 1, at the Bartels Lutheran Retirement Community in Waverly.

He was born Sept. 11, 1919, in Parkersburg, the son of William D. and Bonita (Reed) Olmstead. He married Charlotte D. Hills on Jan. 26, 1946 in Cedar Falls. She died Mar. 13, 1981. He then married Ailene R. (Aarons) Philp on Oct. 31, 1981 in Cedar Falls.

Mr. Olmstead served in the US Army Air Force during World War II. He was employed as a machinist with Titus Manufacturing in Waterloo for 23 years, and then with Viking Pump, retiring in 1981.
