CEDAR FALLS- Evelyn B. Knapp, 86, of Cedar Falls, died Tuesday, August 3, 2010 at Windsor Nursing and Rehab Center.

She was born February 29, 1924 in rural Cedar Falls, daughter of Niels J. and Anna K. (Jensen) Mikkelsen. She married Clifford D. Knapp on July 22, 1945 in Cedar Falls. He died October 8, 1947.

She worked at J.S. Latta and was employed for thirty-seven years at the University of Northern Iowa, retiring in 1989 as Office Coordinator of Career Planning and Placement Center.
