December 11, 1927 - October 2, 2020

Cedar Falls – Flora Marie Brewster, age 92 of Cedar Falls died Friday, October 2, 2020 at Western Home Communities - Martin Suites.

She was born December 11, 1927, in Battle Creek Iowa, the daughter of Harry and Mathilda (Greenwald) Ericksen. On October 23, 1960, Flora was united in marriage to Marvin Brewster in Cedar Falls. He preceded her in death on June 2, 2020.

Flora graduated from Battle Creek High School in 1946. After graduation, she attended Iowa State Teachers College (UNI) and began the first Gamma Delta Chapter at the Teachers College for College Hill Lutheran Church. She received her LPN license and worked at Sartori Hospital and Old Folks Home (Western Home). Then received her dental assistance license and worked for Dr. Frost in Waterloo. She stayed at home to raise two children, then returned to work at both Peet Junior High School in food service and Cedar Falls Woman's Club as a cook. She retired from Cedar Falls Community Schools in 1991.

For many years, Flora volunteered in the Golden Apple program at Waterloo Schools and was a Camp Fire Girls Leader for 15 years. She continued to be an active volunteer at Sartori Hospital and Western Home Communities. She was a charter member of College Hill Lutheran Church, lifetime member of the

Cedar Falls Woman's Club, and Cedar Falls AMVETS Post 49 Ladies Auxiliary.

Flora is survived by her daughter, Cindy (Scott) Loder of Cedar Falls; a son, Rodney Brewster of Ames, IA; two granddaughters, Ashley (Phil) Tieu of West Des Moines, IA, and Kayla (Aaron) Moore of Waverly, IA; four great grandchildren: Luna Tieu, Jaxon, Jaycee, and Jager Moore; and her beloved sister, Dorothea Berning of Cedar Falls.

She was preceded in death by her husband Marvin.

Private graveside services will be held in Garden of Memories Cemetery, Waterloo. Richardson Funeral Service is assisting the family.
