July 30, 1913 - January 23, 2011

CEDAR FALLS- Franklin A. Reeves, 96, of the Cedar Falls Lutheran Home, died Sunday, January 23, 2011 at the Lutheran Home.

Franklin was born July 30, 1914, in Pisgah, Iowa, the son of Frank Martin and Clara Matilda (Lane) Reeves. On December 25, 1934, he was united in marriage to Mildred Turpen in Pleasanton, Iowa. Mildred died December 5, 1998. Franklin and Mildred owned and operated the Pleasanton General Store until 1952, and he later was employed by the United States Department of Defense.

Franklin is survived by his son, Dr. Lane (Joanne) Reeves of Cedar Falls, four grandsons, Gregory (Stephanie) Reeves of Madison Lake, MN, Dr. Andrew (Jennifer) Reeves of Mankato, MN, Douglas (Brenda) Reeves of Estherville, IA and Rodney (Christine) Mickelson of Cedar Rapids, IA; and eight great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his daughter, Carol (Roger) Reeves Mickelson. Services are scheduled for 2:00 PM Tuesday, January 25, 2011, at the Community of Christ Church in Cedar Falls, with interment in the Rose Hill Cemetery in Lamoni, IA on Wednesday. Visitations will be 4 to 7 p.m. Monday at the Richardson Funeral Home in Cedar Falls, and one hour prior to the services at the church.
