Cedar Falls – Gary Lee Hansen, age 79, of Cedar Falls died Friday, October 4, 2019 at his home.

He was born August 26, 1940, the son of C. Victor and Muriel (Allyn) Hansen in Waterloo. He graduated from Dubuque High School in 1958 and attended Iowa State University to study engineering. He was drafted into the US Army during the Vietnam War.
