CEDAR FALLS- Gary M. McInroy, 73, of Cedar Falls, died Sunday, August 3, 2014, at his home.

He was born March 7, 1941, in Cedar Falls, son of Merle L. and Opal A. (Davids) McInroy. He married Norma Fulcher on November 18, 1961 in Waterloo.
