George Thomas Clark (1927-2016)

NEW HARTFORD - George Thomas Clark, 88, of New Hartford, died Sunday January 3, 2016, at the Cedar Valley Hospice Home in Waterloo.

He was born December 10, 1927 in Oelwein, son of George L. Clark and Julia Robinson Clark. He married Emmy Heiple in 1947, they later divorced. He married Dorothy Jean Bohnsack on September 28, 1958. She died August 27, 2004.

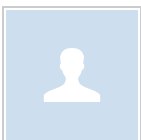
