



## George Hillson

George S. Hillson, 82, of Forest City and formerly of Cedar Falls, died Thursday, July 1, 2004, at the Belmond Care Center, Belmond, Iowa. George was born February, 27, 1922, in Arlington, Iowa, the son of Ray Frank and Mary Olive (Baker) Hillson. He married Dorothy Tripp in October of 1941 and later divorced.
