George was born August 8, 1921, in Ponca, Nebraska, the son of Harry J. and Gladys (Douthitt) Mattison. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from Iowa State University and served his Country in the United States Army Air Corp during World War II. On January 2, 1949, he was united in marriage to Beverly Ann Anderson in Waterloo. She died December 3, 2000. He was a Project Engineer at the John Deere Product Engineering Center for 37 years, retiring August 31, 1983.
