Gerald was born March 9, 1920, in Kesley, Iowa, the son of John M. and Bertha (Knavel) DeBerg. He graduated from Waterloo East High School in 1937 and went on to serve his Country in the United States Navy during World War II. He married Elaine E. Koch in 1940 and were later divorced. He was employed at the RKO Theater in Los Angeles, CA following the War and in the 1960's moved to Minneapolis working at various jobs.
