CEDAR FALLS - Gordon F. "Gordy" Ubben, 84, died Saturday, September 23, 2023, at The Deery Suites at Western Home Communities.

He was born December 17, 1938, in Waterloo, Iowa, the son of Theodore and Evelyn (Rowson) Ubben. He graduated from Hudson High School in 1957 and later served in the United States Army. He married Barbara Rekers August 10, 1991, in Cedar Falls. Gordy owned and operated Ubben's DX Station in Hudson and later raised hogs, built a commercial lawn service, and worked in maintenance at Land O'Lakes.

He was very involved in the community, serving as a volunteer Fireman for 20 years and driving bus for the Hudson Community School District for 42 years. He loved driving for athletic events and got the opportunity to drive for multiple generations. His faith was strong, and he became a devoted member of Prairie Lakes church.

Any spare time that he had was spent attending his kids' and grandkids' sporting events, playing golf, and cheering on the Hawkeyes. He enjoyed summers boating/fishing with friends and family at their cabin in Clear Lake and more recently, winters in Arizona. Above all, family was his top priority.

Gordy always had a smile for everyone. We will really miss his humor and his

ability to make people feel special, wherever he went.

Gordy is survived by his wife of Cedar Falls; four children, Gwen (Jeff) Bown, Bruce (Polly) Ubben, and Sara (Mike) Ingamells, all of Lincoln, NE and Mitch (Cindy) Ubben of Castle Rock, CO; stepson, Troy (Sheila) Walbaum of Cedar Falls; ten grandchildren; six great grandchildren; and brother, Russell (Rose) Ubben of Oelwein.

He was preceded in death by his parents; and stepson, Eric Walbaum.

Funeral Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, September 30, 2023, at Prairie Lakes Church in Cedar Falls. Visitation will be 4-7 p.m. Friday, September 29th at Prairie Lakes Church. Interment at Greenwood Cemetery in Cedar Falls.
