Grayton T. Fuller (1924-2010)

CEDAR FALLS-Graydon T. Fuller, 85, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, April 19, 2010 at the Western Home Communities-Martin Center in Cedar Falls.

He was born July 19, 1924, in Cedar Falls, Iowa, the son of Graydon "Ted" and Josephine (Markussen) Fuller Sr. He graduated from Cedar Falls High School in 1942 and attended Iowa State Teachers College (UNI) for one year. He served his country in the United States Army during World War II. He married Jeanette Eells in Fairbank, Iowa on June 14, 1946.

He was employed as an electroplater and in shipping and receiving at Doefer's Engineering for 25 years, retiring in 1990. In 1941, he won the State High Board Diving Championship, and later became the diving coach for the Cedar Falls High School Swim team. He loved singing and was very loyal to the United Methodist Church choir and the Les Hale Metropolitan Chorale, and sang for many weddings and funerals.

Survivors include his wife of Cedar Falls; and daughter, Janae Fuller of Lexington, MO.

Services will be held 10:30 a.m. Friday at First United Methodist Church, with
