Guy Wray Jr (1923-2017)

WATERLOO – Guy Wray Jr, 94, of Waterloo, formerly of Cedar Falls died Tuesday, August 29, 2017, at Pinnacle Specialty Care in Cedar Falls.

He was born May 8, 1923 in Parnell, Missouri, son of Guy Wray Sr and Lela Grace (Carmichael) Wray. He married Marlys Webrand on September 14, 1947 in New Hartford, Iowa.

He served in the United States Army with the 36th Infantry Division during WWII and was employed with John Deere, Clay Equipment and then Shield-Bantam, retiring in 1985. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Cedar Falls, where he served as a deacon, and was currently a member of Greenhill Baptist Church in Cedar Falls.
