CEDAR FALLS- Harry John Mercurio, 81, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, September 28, 2009 at Allen Memorial Hospital.

He was born February 1, 1928 in Waterloo, the son of John A. and Nellie (Lane) Mercurio. He married Beverly L. Aldrich on December 23, 1950 in Waterloo.
