WATERLOO – Helen G. Lippold, 99, of Waterloo died Monday, September 17, 2018 at her home.

She was born June 23, 1919 in Green Bay, WI, daughter of Carl Gerhardt Ericksen and Mabel Sophia Gottschalk. She married Donald L. Lippold on July 8, 1950 in Green Bay. He preceded her in death on May 30, 1994.

She attended Lawrence College, the University of Wisconsin and the Philadelphia School of Occupational Therapy.
